

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE MYTHOLOGICAL MEMORY

Cut out all the cards. Turn them face down and shuffle them. The game begins!

The first player turns over two cards of his choice. If he manages to match a god with the symbol that represents it, he keeps the cards. If not, he has to turn them over again. Now it is the turn for the next player, who will have to do the same, and so on.

The winning player is the one who gets the most pairs.
